



Q6 - How prepared are teacher education graduates from the University of Wyoming to manage a classroom effectively?





Q8 - How prepared are teacher education graduates from the University of Wyoming in terms of required content knowledge for their teaching assignments?





Q9 - How prepared are teacher education graduates from the University of Wyoming to apply theories of how children learn?









Q12 - How prepared are teacher education graduates from the University of Wyoming to create classroom environments that model civic engagement?














