
1 **Resolution in Support of General Counsel**
2 **Proposed Changes to Regulation 2-106; Assignment of Grades and**
3 **Creating Standard Administrative Policy and Procedures (SAPP),**

8 **WHEREAS**, at the September 2016 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board approved
9 review by UW Administration of UW’s current regulatory structure, to include the
10 following:

- 11 1) Phasing out presidential directives;
- 12 2) Defining regulation versus policy/procedure;
- 13 3) Creating an online manual, including a new “look” and format for the
14 regulations; and
- 15 4) Updating the substance of the regulations, policies, and procedures as
16 needed, including determining whether there are any substantive gaps; and
17

18 **WHEREAS**, the new structure will involve three levels of policies:

- 19 1) Governing Regulations (Level A),
- 20 2) Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level B), and
- 21 3) Department/Unit Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level C); and
22

23 **WHEREAS**, the University’s Routing Process for new or revised UW Regulations
24 includes review by the Chair of the Faculty Senate; and
25

26 **WHEREAS**, the Chair of the Faculty Senate requested that the Faculty Senate Executive
27 Committee review, and that the Faculty Senate approve, some modifications to the
28 regulations proposed by General Counsel; and

30 **WHEREAS**, the changes to these Regulations have important implications to the
31 University Faculty and to the welfare of the University;
32

33 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming
34 that Faculty Senate supports the adoption of revisions to UW Regulation 2-106;
35 Assignment of Grades and creating SAPP, Assignment of Grades, as proposed by
36 General Counsel.
