
1 **Resolution in Support of General Counsel**
2 **Sunsetting Regulation 2-204; Student Registration and**
3 **Creating Standard Administrative Policy and Procedure (SAPP),**
4 **Student Registration and Census**

7 **WHEREAS**, at the September 2016 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board approved
8 review by UW Administration of UW’s current regulatory structure, to include the
9 following:

- 10 1) Phasing out presidential directives;
11 2) Defining regulation versus policy/procedure;
12 3) Creating an online manual, including a new “look” and format for the
13 regulations; and
14 4) Updating the substance of the regulations, policies, and procedures as
15 needed, including determining whether there are any substantive gaps; and
16

17 **WHEREAS**, the new structure will involve three levels of policies:

- 18 1) Governing Regulations (Level A),
19 2) Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level B), and
20 3) Department/Unit Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level C); and
21

22 **WHEREAS**, the University’s Routing Process for new or revised UW Regulations
23 includes review by the Chair of the Faculty Senate; and
24

25 **WHEREAS**, the Chair of the Faculty Senate requested that the Faculty Senate Executive
26 Committee review, and that the Faculty Senate approve, some modifications to the
27 regulations proposed by General Counsel; and

29 **WHEREAS**, the changes to these Regulations have important implications to the
30 University Faculty and to the welfare of the University;
31

32 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming
33 that Faculty Senate supports the adoption to sunset UW Regulation 2-204; Student
34 Registration, and creating SAPP, Student Registration and Census, as proposed by
35 General Counsel.
