2 **Resolution in Support of General Counsel Proposed UW Regulations 2-10,**
3 ***Post-Tenure Review***
4

5 **WHEREAS**, at the September 2016 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board approved review by
6 UW Administration of UW's current regulatory structure, to include the following:

- 7 1) Phasing out presidential directives;
8 2) Defining regulation versus policy/procedure;
9 3) Creating an online manual, including a new "look" and format for the regulations;
10 and
11 4) Updating the substance of the regulations, policies, and procedures as needed,
12 including determining whether there are any substantive gaps; and
13

14 **WHEREAS**, the new structure will involve three levels of policies:

- 15 1) Governing Regulations (Level A),
16 2) Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level B), and
17 3) Department/Unit Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level C); and
18

19 **WHEREAS**, the University's Routing Process for new or revised UW Regulations includes review
20 by the Chair of the Faculty Senate; and
21

22 **WHEREAS**, the Chair of the Faculty Senate requested that the Faculty Senate Executive
23 Committee review, and that the Faculty Senate approve, some modifications to the regulations
24 proposed by General Counsel; and
25

26 **WHEREAS**, the changes to these Regulations have important implications to the University
27 Faculty and to the welfare of the University;
28

29 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming that Faculty
30 Senate supports the adoption of revisions to UW Regulation 2-10, *Post-Tenure Review*, as
31 proposed by General Counsel, with the adoption of the tracked-change amendments approved
32 by the Faculty Senate as shown on the attached version.
