The program in Professional Child Development is available by distance delivery only. Entry into the program is by admission only. Students must first apply for admission to UW, including submitting official transcripts from all other institutions previously attended. Applicants must also satisfactorily complete a mandatory security screen (background check). Admission to the program will not be considered until all of these steps have been completed. In addition to an associate's degree, applicants must have successfully completed the following courses prior to entry: COJO 1010 (Public Speaking), EDEC 1020 (Intro to Early Childhood Education), PSYC 1000 (General Psychology), and SOC 1000 (Sociological Principles).
