EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

At its March 2020 meeting, the Board voted to allow students to opt-in to S-U grading through April 17, 2020. Student Advising believes that sophomores and juniors, who are the last to receive advise and register, would benefit from additional time to meet with their faculty and advisors to discuss the best options for student success. Thus, the University requests an extension to the temporary exception to UW Regulation 2-106 so as to allow students to opt-in to S-U grading through April 30, 2020.
