1. Staffing

- Development officer position (on hold due to UW hiring freeze)
- 2. CJC revenue figures as of November 1, 2020
 - \$3.41 Million in pledges and \$3.25 Million in cash received (2020)
 Decrease of \$161,249 in cash received from the same time last year (4.7% decrease)
 - Nice improvement over the past several months. We were well over a 10% decrease in cash donations back in July & August....nearly 20% decrease back in May
- 3. WHYoming Now Campaign
 - Started campaign in August and recently concluded
 - \$1,100,000+ -- Cash donations
 - \$ 200,000+ -- FB season tickets donated
 - \$ 100,000+ -- Wildcatter season tickets initially donated *
 - <u>\$1.4 Million</u> -- Total
